The World Series starts Friday and ends Monday. There are 5 games guaranteed.
Finals will be played Monday.
Senior Softball Canada will follow NSA Canada rules with the exception of the following:
Equalizer Rule - Seniors divisions
The following equalizer rule will be in effect when or if Divisions combine during Round Robin play

This rule will be in effect only for the round robin portion of the tournament. Rules:
$\square$ Three (3) game seeding rounds to seed elimination bracket
$\square$ Elimination bracket is a Double Knock-out format

$\square$ Home Runs - Five (5) per team per game. All home runs beyond 5 will be an out.
$\square$ Run Rules - Five (5) runs per inning maximum exception for the open inning
$\square$ Mercy Rule - 15 runs after the 3rd or 4th inning and 10 runs after the 5th or 6th
$\square$ Time Limits

- Round Robin - 90 minutes
- Bracket Games - 90 minutes
- Championship Games - 7 full innings
$\square$ Tie-breakers - Head to head (in full RR only), lowest runs allowed, true plus minus, coin toss
$\square$ 8-foot commitment line going home
$\square$ Safety line (scoring line) will be used for ALL senior games
$\square$ Courtesy running - every player is allowed to run once per inning with no carry over (see Rule 8, Note 1, SENIOR)
$\square \quad$ No bunting or stealing
$\square$ For example a player to be considered a 40-year old they must be 40 years of age as of December 31 of the current year and so on for all Master/Senior Divisions. (35+, 40+, 50+, 55+, 60+ \& 65+)
$\square$ In each division each team is permitted 2 players under the Division group.
$\square$ Each Division is allowed 2 underage players but not more then 2 years under age as of December 31 of the current year.
$\square$ Prize money depends on the number of teams entered in each division.
