Series Rules

There are 5 games guaranteed.

ALL NSA Canada rules with the exception of the following:

Equalizer Rule – Seniors divisions

The following equalizer rule will be in effect when the 50+ and 55+ play each other in round robin play.

The 55+ team will be awarded runs in the following format; if a 60+ team drops to 50+ they will be granted 2 runs per inning, up to and including the 5th inning. When playing the 55+ teams the regular one division format will apply.

Rules:

- Three (3) game seeding rounds to seed elimination bracket
- Elimination bracket is a Double Knock-out format
- Home Runs - Five (5) and one up.
- The one up rule is in effect only after both teams have reached their home run limit.
- Once both teams have reached their home run limit, each team may hit an additional home run, however, no team may ever go more than one home run up on the other team. Any additional home runs above the one up will be scored as an out.
- EXCEPTION:** If the visiting team is even or up one home run on the home team in the bottom of the last inning or any extra innings, the home team may hit only one home run in that inning.
- Run Rules -- Five (5) runs per inning maximum exception for the open inning.
- Mercy Rule -- 15 runs after the 3rd or 4th inning and 10 runs after the 5th or 6th
- Time Limits -- 75-90 minutes, Championship games 7 innings if possible
- Tie-breakers – Head to head (in full RR only), lowest runs allowed, true plus minus, coin toss
- 8-foot commitment line going home
- Safety line (scoring line) will be used for ALL senior games
- Courtesy running – every player is allowed to run once per inning with no carry over (see Rule 8, Note 1, SENIOR)
- No bunting or stealing
- For a player to be considered a 50-year old they must be 50 years of age as of December 31 of the current year and so on for all Senior Divisions. (50+, 55+, 60+, 65+ & 70+)
- In each division each team is permitted 2 players under the Division group.
- Each Division is allowed 2 underage players but not more then 2 years under age as of December 31 of the current year
- Prize money depends on the number of teams entered in each division
